8. **Public Hearing** Relative to FY 2018 5310 Elderly and Disabled Transportation Grant through the North Carolina Department of Transportation (grant will fund the position of Mobility Manager and transportation after normal business hours for the elderly, disabled and general public - \$160,000; local match required - \$66,000; will be generated by services and funds from Transit Fund Balance).
