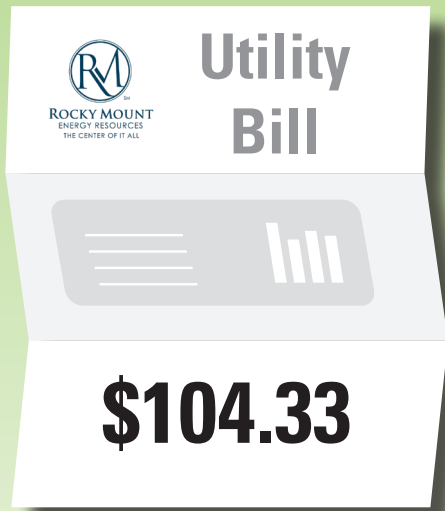


How much is your electric bill?



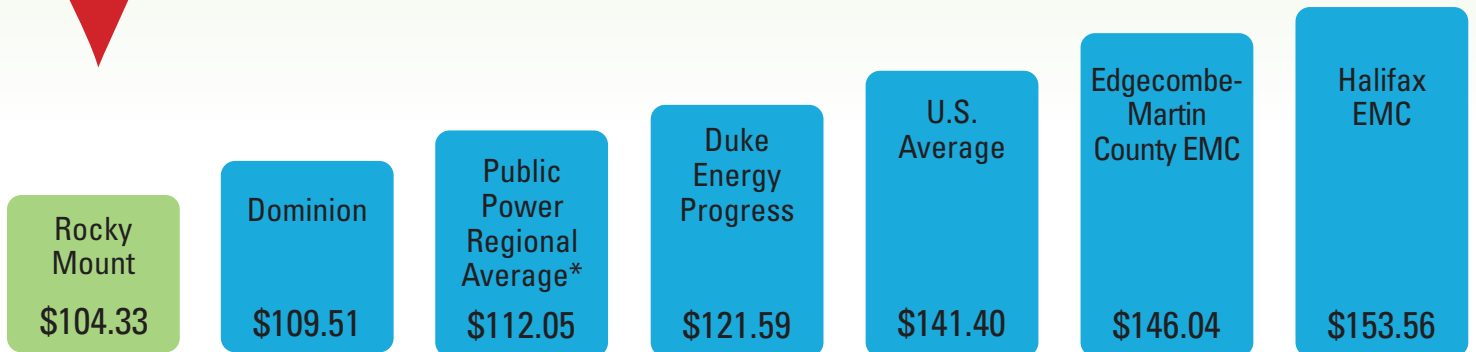
The average city of Rocky Mount residential electric customer pays **\$104.33 per month.**

This is based on 1,000 kilowatt-hours (kWh) of usage with all three Load Management Program credits.

How does this compare to other utilities?



The average electric costs for city of Rocky Mount residential customers are lower than the surrounding utilities, including investor-owned, electric cooperatives and other Public Power utilities. In fact, Rocky Mount's average residential electric customer pays 26% less than the U.S. average!
