Following is a list of appointments to be considered:

- Animal Care and Control Advisory Board - three (3) appointments: Wards 1, 2, and 7;
- Board of Adjustment - two (2) appointments: (2) Alternate Members;
- Business Development Authority – one (1) appointment (Mayoral appointments);
- Central City Revitalization Panel - four (4) appointments: one (1) Historic Preservation Commission; one (1) Commercial Builder/Developer; and two (2) Ex-Officios;
- Community Appeals Board - two (2) appointments: Wards 2, and 4;
- Historic Preservation Commission – one (1) appointment;
- Mayor’s Commission on Persons with Disabilities – one (1) appointment;
- Planning Board - one (1) appointment – Ward 4;
- Tree Advisory Board – one (1) appointment – Ward 2;
