

At the Boys & Girls Clubs of the Tar River Region, we provide the best care for our youth afterschool and during the summer.



In the summer, we work to keep kids learning with programs like Summer Brain Gain. This program helps to ensure our youth stay up-to-date with their academics before they start back to school.










NEW LEADERSHIP



AT-PROMISE ACADEMY




The At Promise Academy seeks to address the ongoing challenges young African-American male students face in "at-risk communities" by ensuring that students have the well-rounded support and robust set of services they need to excel in their academics and become "At Promise" instead of "At Risk." We are seeking African-American male students in the sixth grade to join our academy.

At-Promise Academy Benefits:

- Certified Teachers to tutor in the subjects of Math,
 Language Arts, and Science
- Enrichment programs including STEM; homework help; college and career preparedness and high-yield learning activities
- Social-emotional wellness support programs, including trauma-informed care and virtual mentoring

- STE(A)M programming and project-based learning opportunities
- ------ Leadership Development
 - Summer Brain Gain, an engaging evidence-based curriculum to prevent summer learning loss designed for out-of-school time




AT-PROMISE ACADEMY + ENTREPRENEURSHIP


