GENERAL INFORMATION

ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION

- Participation in the Senior Games is limited to persons ages 50 and over. Proof age will be required. Participants must be a North Carolina resident for а minimum months of the year. consecutive Competition will be by age and sex divisions as follows: 50-54, 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70-74, 75-79, 80-84, 85-89, 90-94, 95-99, 100+
- Your age as of December 31, 2024, will determine the age category in which you will compete.
- No event will be delayed for latecomers. No shows = no refunds. Check-in for all events starts 15 minutes prior to the listed start time. Picture ID is required.
- Safety and sportsmanlike conduct are paramount. Down East Senior Games officials have the authority to disqualify, and/or remove anyone who exhibits inappropriate behavior or a condition of medical concern.
- Remember: In doubles events, the age of the younger player is used to determine age group for competition. In team events, the age of the youngest player on team roster determines age group for competition.
- For SilverArts Participants: All entries must be original works of the artist. Work must be created after age 50, and within the last 2 years. Entries are only eligible for judging or display if they have never been entered in any SilverArts competition before: records are kept and your piece will be disqualified if recognized.

State Finals qualification criteria returns to pre-covid with the exception of open events. The Full qualification policy is as follows: The top three male and female qualifiers in each official North Carolina Senior Games sport/event in each age category will be eligible to participate in State Finals except:

- 1. Bowlers: places 1-6
- 2. Golfers must meet a minimum performance score (MPS) and finish 1, 2 or 3 to qualify.
- All participants who complete a Local Games Fun Walk, Football Throw, Softball Throw and Basketball Shooting will qualify.
- Teams: The first, second and third place teams per the team sport age category will qualify.

GOLF & CYCLING

Golf: Registration for Golf is a flat \$25.00, and the event will be hosted on Tuesday, April 9, 2024 at Wedgewood Golf Course in Wilson, NC. If you are only participating in Golf then you only have to pay the \$25.00 fee.
