Veterans Memorial at Jack Laughery Park



The Rocky Mount Veterans Memorial at Jack Laughery Park honors men and women who have served in America's Armed Forces throughout its history, and who have preserved and protected our citizens' freedom. The project is a joint effort of the City of Rocky Mount, local veterans, and friends of Jack Laughery.

The memorial allows local residents to pay lasting tribute to those who served. Every man and woman with a tie to Nash and Edgecombe County who has, or is still serving our country's armed forces are eligible to have a customized memorial brick paver for the walkways. The memorial includes a series of five stone columns, commemorating each branch of the armed forces. The park has a water feature, park benches, and flagpoles for the colors of our nation, state, and city. Customized lighting and thoughtful landscaping of plants and trees creates a meditative setting for visitors.
