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Requirements to Laterally Transfer Military Police Certification:

- Be a current, or honorably discharged military police officer
- Successfully completed a military police training program and been awarded a military police occupational specialty rating
- Meet the minimum standards for law enforcement officers in NC (see below)
- Engaged in active practice of military police officer duties in any branch of military service, active or reserve, for not less than two of the five years preceding the date of the application.

Requirements to Apply:

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be at least 20 years of age
- Be of good moral character as determined by a background investigation
- Not have been convicted of any of the following:
 - A Felony,
 - A crime punishable by more than 2 years imprisonment,
 - An offense involving moral turpitude
- Be a high school graduate or have passed the General Education Development (GED) test indicating high school equivalency
- Have a valid N.C. Driver's License
- Have visual activity sufficient to safely and efficiently perform the essential job functions; vision must be corrected by 20/20
- Reside within fifty (50) direct miles of the center of Rocky Mount (designated as the intersection of S. Church Street and Nash Street)
